Antisemitism is up 388% since last year. With Hanukkah starting on December 7th, many Jews must reconcile their fears with the very public, centuries-old tradition of placing menorahs in their windows during the holiday.

We are less than 2% of the population of America and less than 0.2% of the world. Jewish families are feeling isolated and scared. Wonderfully, many non-Jewish friends and allies are asking how they can help.

Like my friend Jennifer Marshall. I told Jen what happened, and without hesitation, she said, "I'll put a menorah in our window too. You are not alone." With that simple, selfless gesture of love, Project Menorah was born.

Project Menorah invites non-Jewish allies to place a menorah in their window, along with their other seasonal decorations – and then post about it on their social media using the hashtags #onlyloveliveshere #projectmenorah.
